
There will be a hand sanitizer station at the main entrance to the Astro Turf.

Llandeilo Covid Officers also to set up sanitizing stations as per Cae William set up.

Those wishing to use the Sports Hall, Gym, Toilets to follow the markers into the building. There will be sanitiser stations outside the Sports Hall, Gym and Toilets. The changing facilities are not in use. Signage will be in evidence, recommending usage of the sanitisers and advise 2 metres social distancing.

TSF is recommending that organisers arrive 10 minutes before the start of the session to wipe down surface i.e. door handles and to set up their equipment. Whilst TSF will arrange that there is sufficient time between appointments but if there is an overlap, the group using the hall should leave by the rear exit and follow the path back to the exit using the arrows & signage.

TSF will install by each toilet block hand sanitisers together with limiting users to just one person at a time. Usage of the Toilets will be on a one in one out basis and again hand washing with soap and water is strongly recommended. The showers and changing room facilities are out of bounds until further notice.
